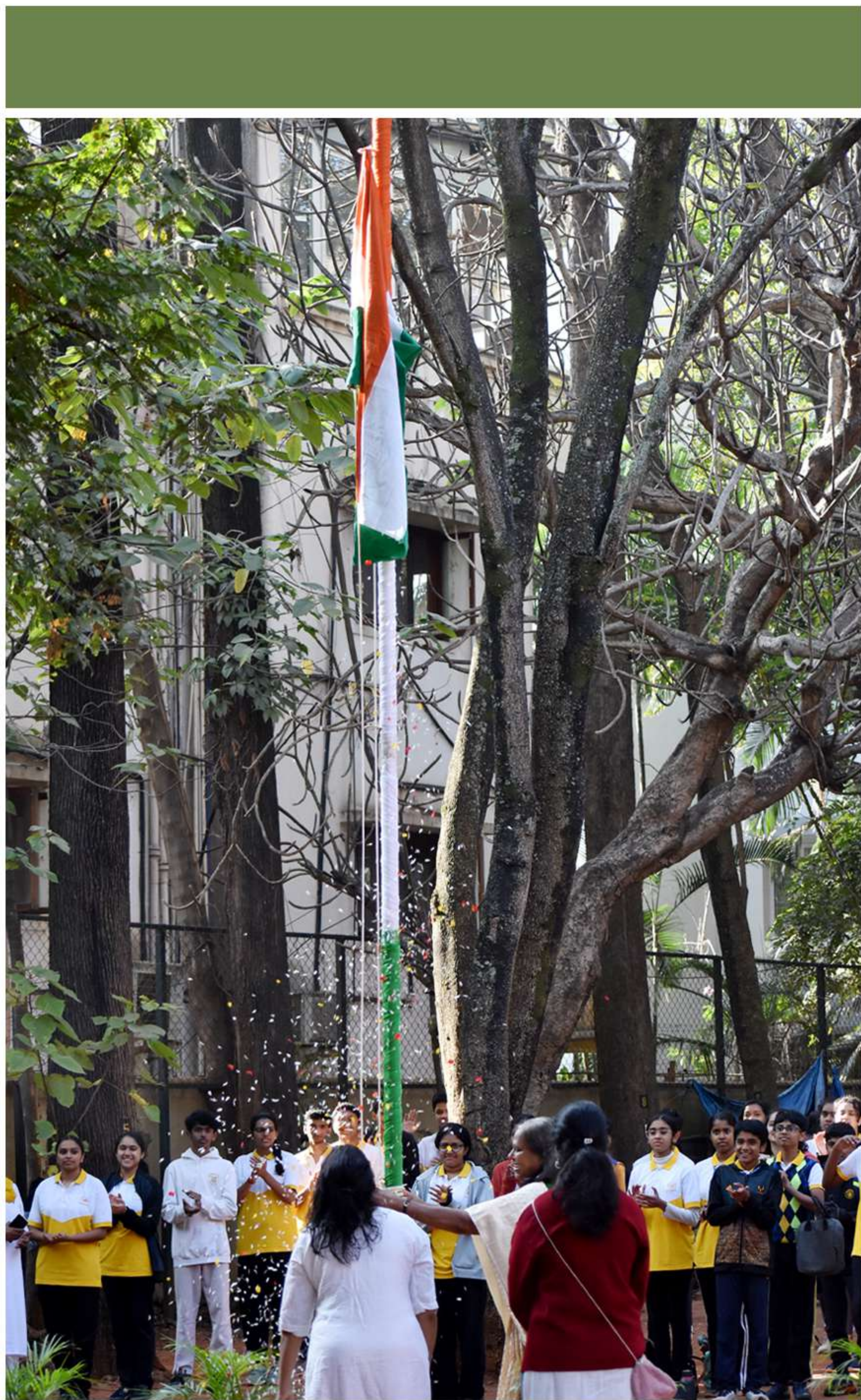
Aurolympics

The surprise video played in the wisdom courtyard of the 10th graders growing up in AMIS will be cherished by them for life!



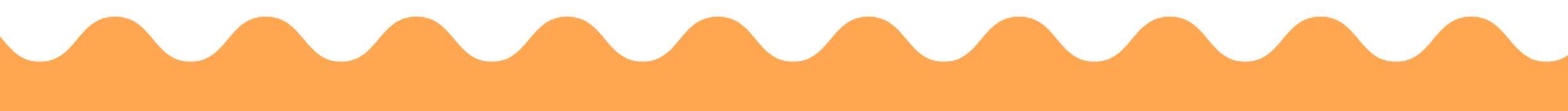
Display day
