हिंदी — हमारी पहचान, हमारी शक्ति

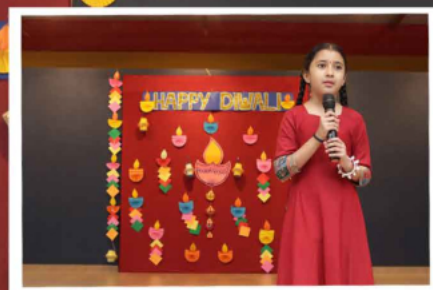

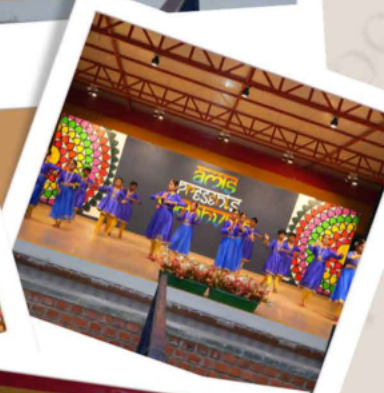
